Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC."

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS - Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

2. Following normal breed judging, the puppy winners from the 6-9 month and the 9-12 month classes will return to the ring where a Best Puppy in the breed will be selected.
3. If a puppy from the stated puppy classes wins Best of Breed or Best of Winners in the regular classes, that puppy will automatically win the Best Puppy in breed competition.
4. The puppy named best in its breed will proceed to the Puppy Group.

FRIDAY - BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION

Judge: Mr. Larry Dewey

On Friday as part of its group show, Toy Dog Breeders Association of Southern California, Inc. will hold a Best Bred by Competition. Competition will be for Best of Breed or Variety Bred by and Best Bred by in Group (placements 1 through 4).

RULES:

The same rules that apply to eligibility to compete in the regular Bred-By-Exhibitor classes apply to eligibility to compete in Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in Breed or Variety, Group 1-4. During the course of regular breed judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the class winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes. This will be done after Best of Breed judging unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs or bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present the second place winner may not compete.

All Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Dog/Bitches will compete in their respective Bred-By-Exhibitor Group. THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE FOR THIS COMPETITION. ONLY ENTRIES IN THE REGULAR BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR COMPETITION.

PRIZES AND RIBBONS: a flat ribbon to be awarded to Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in each breed or variety and a small rosette for group placements.

CLASSES: (Divided by sex) 6 & under 9 months, 9 & under 12 months, 12 & under 18 months.

DIVISION OF MONEY: 35% is retained by District 7 to defray expenses; the remaining 65% will be divided in each class as follows: 1st – 50%, 2nd 25%, 3rd 15%, 4th 10%. Any prize money not allocated as provided above shall be returned to District 7.

Veterans Sweepstakes - Friday

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Toy Manchester Terriers who, on the day of the show will be 7 years of age or older. Judging will be held prior to Regular Classes. The Sweepstakes entry must be noted on the regular class entry form under "Additional Classes". Fees must accompany entries (\$16.00).

CLASSES: (Divided by sex) 7 & under 10 years; 10 years and older.

DAY OF SHOW PARKING RULES

Some parking areas may be some distance from your ring(s). **An unloading area will be provided.** Please follow the instructions of parking attendants. Day-of-Show parking will be \$8.00 per space. Vehicles requiring more than one space (motor homes, etc.) will be parked in the day-of-show overflow parking lot and will be charged \$8.00 per space used. **No setups or x-pens will be allowed in day-of-show parking lots.** No overnight parking will be allowed in the day of show parking lots. **Anyone not following KCPS rules risks having his/her vehicle towed at owners' expense. No abusive behavior will be tolerated.** KCPS and Empire Polo Club assume no responsibility for fire, theft or damage to vehicles or cargo, whether legally or illegally parked. **Overnight parking is not permitted on the streets in Indio.**

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

1. Day-of-show parking for cars and small vans may be on grass. There will be no setups allowed in day-of-show parking area.
2. All parking on streets adjacent to the show site will be subject to local regulations and restrictions.
3. No unentered dogs will be allowed on the show grounds.
4. Unloading zones will be indicated; cars may not be left unattended. Cars are not to remain in unloading zone over 10 minutes. Please unload and move your vehicle from the loading zone to the general parking area, as directed, and return to your dog(s) and equipment. Helpers will be available to assist.
5. Guards will be on duty Friday and Saturday nights and on the days of the shows, but neither KCPS nor Empire Polo Club can be responsible for property left unattended under grooming tents.
6. No exercise pens or setups will be allowed within 20 feet of any ring, in the center aisles, or in any other area posted "No Setups". Areas under grooming tents will be available on a first come, first served basis. No exercise pens will be permitted under grooming tents. Please make the best possible use of this space and be considerate of other exhibitors.
7. Dogs/crates are allowed under main tents only during judging for that breed - **NO EXCEPTIONS** - unattended dogs/crates will be removed by K.C.P.S. ONE crate per dog will be permitted in the center aisle, and it must be removed immediately after each dog is excused from further judging on that day. No crates are to be left overnight.
8. KCPS is not responsible for providing electricity for exhibitors' use.
9. Grounds will not be available for setups until after 3 p.m. Thursday, except for English Setters, Black and Tan Coonhounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Doberman Pinschers, Chinese Crested, Shih Tzu and Non-Sporting exhibitors. There may be some distance from setup area to your ring(s). Please allow enough time to get to your ring on time.
10. Events or circumstances not covered in these operating policies and procedures may be subject to special consideration and stipulations, as deemed appropriate by Empire Polo management.
11. The use of flexi-leads will not be permitted on the show grounds.

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 5434 East Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles CA, 90022, by Noon, Wednesday December 23, 2009 PST. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly. In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent's office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rulebooks are available at the Superintendent's table at the shows or may be obtained from the A.K.C., PO Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051.
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
10. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
11. Declination of Entries. The Toy Dog Breeders of Southern California, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
14. A Recording Fee of 50 cents per dog and an Event Services Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 10, Section 2.)
15. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
16. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
17. No setups/x-pens in Day of Show Parking lot.
18. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
19. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 11 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 11 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Competition is required for Best Junior Handler.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, A.K.C., PO Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675-9051.

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank.

OVERNIGHT PARKING INFORMATION

There are three overnight parking areas: two are adjacent to the show area and one is some distance away. Most of the parking is on decomposed granite. One limited area is on grass, weather permitting. Vehicles parked on grass will be required to have ground cover placed under their generators and exhaust pipes to protect the grass. No dumping of gray water or sewage is allowed.

Please note the following parking requirements/restrictions:

1. Those wishing to park together must arrive together.
2. Space changing will not be permitted. All vehicles must park as directed by parking personnel.
3. Confirmation of your reservation will be sent if you enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
4. All personal generators must be turned off between 11 pm and 6 am daily.
5. All tag vehicles will be required to purchase a tag vehicle pass (\$20.00 for the weekend).
6. Tag vehicles must fit into assigned space (not in aisle), or be moved to day-of-show parking area.
7. Any motor home over 40' long must have two spaces.
8. Any truck & trailer over 40' must have two spaces, or unhook; note on form.
9. All parking spaces are 22' wide by 35' long; over 35' will be parked in designated rows.
10. No foul or abusive language will be tolerated; anyone not following parking rules will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given.

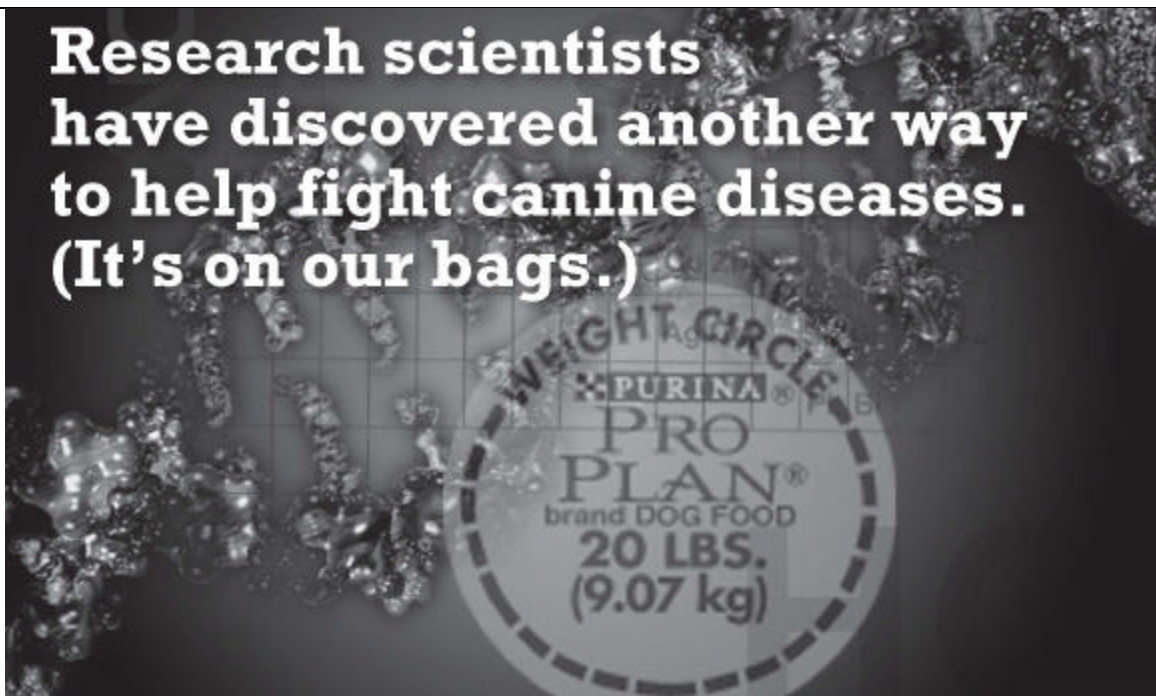
