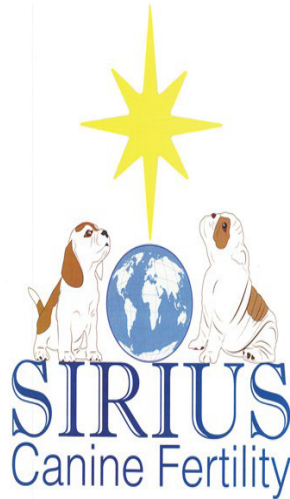

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

The club has a contract with the "Official Photographer(s)" listed in the Premium Lists for its shows. Official Photographers have exclusive rights to take win photographs at these shows, including designated specialties. All other photographers are absolutely prohibited from taking win photographs at these events. A "win photograph" is one in which a winning dog is standing on or near a stand or placard, or both, bearing a club's logo and/or name, while its handler is being presented with prize ribbons or rosettes by a judge, and any other prizes and trophies, for the win.

A "Specialty Photographer" is one who has been authorized by a specialty club to take win photographs of dogs at its concurrent specialty show. The Specialty Photographer has the exclusive right to take win photographs at the concurrent specialty show only.

A "Professional Photographer" is one who is engaged in taking candid ringside and other photographs of dogs at dog shows for profit. Such photographers may be self-employed, work freelance, work for hire or work for publication. Professional Photographers are only permitted to take such photographs on the show grounds by joint invitation of the all-breed clubs, and after obtaining proper identification issued by the clubs.

An "Amateur Photographer" is any photographer other than those types defined above. Amateur Photographers may take any photographs on the show grounds, except win photographs, provided they do not interfere with the judging process or ring procedure, and further provided the photographs are for their own personal use.

All photographers are welcome to use "The Best Day Ever" sign inside the building to frame any of your photographs.

Please contact Larry Fenner at lfenner1963@gmail.com with any photography issue. Photographers required to obtain permission and identification prior to taking photographs are encouraged to do so well in advance so you will be ready to shoot at the start of the show.

GROOMING INFORMATION

No dogs may be left in the buildings overnight. Sir Francis Drake Kennel Club, Inc. are not responsible for grooming equipment left unattended. All dogs and equipment must be removed from the building one hour after Best in Show judging concludes Sunday evening.

Dog Bathing on the Fairgrounds. The Clean Water Act is enforced at the Yolo County Fairgrounds. All gray water (soapy water from bathing dogs) must be discharged into sanitary sewer systems only and not dumped onto the ground or into storm drains. A hefty fine can be levied against offenders. All dog bathing must be done in the designated area. Gray water from "table bathing" must be disposed of in restroom's sanitary sewer systems or deposited in motor home's sanitary systems.

IMPORTANT NOTICES TO ALL EXHIBITORS AND ATTENDEES

The club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children each day of the shows.

NO FORCED AIR DRYERS ALLOWED IN ANY BUILDING.

No exercise pens are allowed in the building.

No crates or setups allowed in the building overnight.

Crates and setups must be kept at least 10 feet from all rings and vendor booths.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates, outdoor setups and RVs.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.

The Clubs assume no responsibility for dogs or equipment left unattended.

Building must be vacated one hour after Best in Show on Sunday.

Restrooms are not to be used for bathing dogs or mixing food.

Cars are not to remain in unloading zones more than 20 minutes.

Cleaning up after your own dogs is your responsibility. These are Self-Cleaning shows. If your dog soils the grounds it is your responsibility to clean it up. The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class.

The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5 to under 9 years of age at all shows offering Pee Wee.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- Dogs do not have to be AKC registered.
- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release forms will be available at the show.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern.

Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word 'judge' will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience -- no Junior will be 'judged' but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored. One child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time. Each child will receive a participation rosette to commemorate the experience!

Motorized Vehicles and/or Scooter and Bike Rules

For those exhibitors that bring their own motorized vehicles, Golf Carts, scooters, e-bikes or pedal bikes (either pedal, gasoline or electric powered) onto the show grounds, please be aware that we will enforce the following rules:

1. No unlicensed driver or children under age of 16 will be allowed to operate any motorized vehicle on the fairgrounds.
2. For the safety of all exhibitors and dogs, due to limited space, a speed limit of 5 mph must be observed.
3. Use of motorized vehicles or bikes indoors, a speed limit of 2 mph must be observed.
4. Any liability concerning an incident is the responsibility of the individual owner of the motorized vehicle or bike.

Regulations Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition, and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition, and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

Exhibition Only in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy (BPUP) Competition The regulations for the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy (BPUP) competition have been modified to allow professional handlers to exhibit dogs they own for exhibition only. Dogs must be marked as exhibition only on their entry form and are subject to the entry fees and eligibility requirements of the class. The exhibition only status of an entry may not be changed after the closing of entries. Exhibition only entries will be judged (examined and gaited) as all other entries but will not be considered for awards. Exhibition only entries will not be included in the calculation of Certificate of Merit (CM) and Puppy of Achievement (POA) points. Exhibition only entries in BPUP is available for events occurring on or after July 31, 2024.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS. .AKC Revised 5/11/18*

The following breeds may be examined on the ground, table or ramp: Miniature Bull Terrier.

Junior showmanship judges should follow the above.

1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 320 Maple Avenue, Torrance, CA 90503 by Noon Wednesday August 26, 2026, PT. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be emailed to the email address on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent's office advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available online at akc.org.
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors' setups will be allowed in the aisles, and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees should NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$5.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
10. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
11. Declination of Entries. The club and may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club(s) or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
14. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
15. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
16. Dogs, which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
17. No practice is allowed in rings at any time.
18. Parents and/or Guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
19. Bitches in season are ineligible to compete in trials. To receive a refund, a veterinarian's letter needs to be received by the Superintendent no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. There will be a \$4.00 fee charged for bitch in season cancellations.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time, entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time, entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, go online at www.akc.org.

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank.

VETERAN (divided by sex) 7 years of age and older

Neutered Veteran Dogs & Spayed Veteran Bitches may be entered at Independent Specialty Shows and Concurrent Specialty Shows.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition - "The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC."

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.
