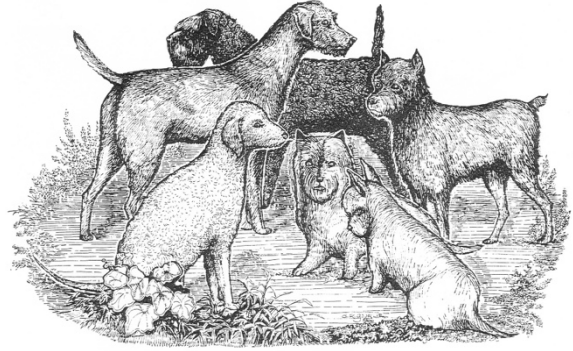

RAMP – The following breeds must be examined on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniel, English Springer Spaniel, Sussex Spaniel, Basset Hound, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terrier, Bulldog, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chow, Keeshond, Spanish Water Dog.

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be examined on a ramp through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever, American Water Spaniel, Boykin Spaniels, Field Spaniel, Welsh Springer Spaniel, Basenji, Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Norwegian Elkhound, Whippet, German Pinscher, Portuguese Water Dog, Standard Schnauzer, American Staffordshire Terrier, Irish Terrier, Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdog, Mudi, Norwegian Buhund, Polish Lowland Sheepdog, Puli, Norrbottenspet.

The following breeds may be examined on the ground, table or ramp: Miniature Bull Terrier.

Junior showmanship judges should follow the above.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to examine any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.) 1/1/26



DIRECTIONS TO VENTURA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to- Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

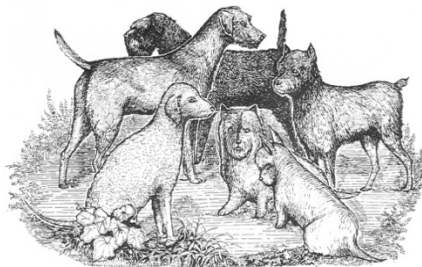

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw, 320 Maple Avenue, Torrance, CA 90503, by Noon, Wednesday December 31, 2025 PT. Fees should accompany entries. These clubs and their Superintendents assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agents of the owner. These clubs and its Superintendents assume no responsibility for entry by the owner or owners agents of a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be emailed to the email address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the Superintendent.
4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judge will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his or her dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the Superintendent's office should be advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rulebooks are available online at www.akc.org
7. The club, its Superintendents and their employees will not be responsible for loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether as the result of accident or for any other cause and no responsibility is assumed for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No crates, crates with carts, grooming tables, nor exercise pens will be allowed in the aisles. Setups, crates, equipment, etc. are to be in designated areas only, except as otherwise specifically authorized by the Show Chair, and will not be allowed in any other areas.
9. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of any entry fee for a duplicate entry. There will be a \$4.00 fee charged for cancellation of an entry prior to closing of entries.
10. There is no provision offered for un-entered dogs at this show.
11. Declination of Entries. The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Clubs or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of these clubs, or management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
14. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the start of the earliest conformation judging at the show.
15. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.
16. No alcohol is allowed on the grounds.
17. No practicing is allowed in the rings at any time.
