BEGINNER NOVICE IS NOT LIMITED

**Entries close at 11:59 PM, Wednesday, August 4, 2021** after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, changed, or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11 Section 6 of the dog show Rules. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of an entry prior to the closing of entries

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds.

Entries not on Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. Entry Form must show the name of the Club and the date of the show.

**AGREEMENT WITH ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED.**

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by phone are not acceptable. Move-ups allowed until 30 minutes prior to start of trial.

Entry fee will not be refunded when a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or banned from competition by action of the Show Committee. Refund of entry fees for bitches that come in season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Trial Secretary. This certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Trial Secretary before the start of the show.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the Club or the Trial Secretary control.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Trial Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. **IF YOU HAVE A CONFLICT PLEASE LET THE GATE STEWARDS KNOW BEFOREHAND AND WE'LL MAKE SURE THAT YOU ARE AFFORDED THE OPPORTUNITY TO GET YOUR RUNS IN AND SHOW/TRIAL IN OTHER EVENTS.**

It is advised that owners and agents be familiar with the Agreement on following the entry form.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against The Santa Maria Kennel Club or its members, OR the Santa Maria Fairpark or its employees, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.**

It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience ring or confined in crates.

**THIS IS A SELF-CLEANING TRIAL. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Unless otherwise noted, all trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. None will be mailed.

**MOVE UPS: Prior to the Trials:** Dogs shall be moved up to a higher obedience or rally class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an obedience or rally title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary not later than noon Pacific Standard Time on Wednesday, August 4, 2021. E-mail notice is acceptable. **Day-to-day:** Move-ups between days will be allowed. The request to move-up must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial or the evening before the Sunday trial.

Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class and judges are available and the class has not reached its limit.

COVID BEST PRACTICES  
(AS OF THE RELEASE OF THIS PREMIUM LIST)

General: Out of respect for our judges, our management team, our volunteers, and your fellow competitors; we require that exhibitors abide by the following best practices, if you are unable to abide by these rules, please reconsider entering our trial.

NOTE: People who are sick or who have been in known contact with people who have COVID-19 should take stronger measures than physical distancing to reduce the risk of infecting others. People with symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 should contact their healthcare provider and consider testing for COVID-19.

- Unless vaccinated, masks covering the nose and mouth are required to be worn at all times while on the show grounds; Masks do not have to be worn if you are in your set-up area.
- Social distancing at a minimum of six feet is required whenever possible.
- We will have hand sanitizer wipes or spray or gel available for your use at each ring.
- If you choose to wear gloves on the show grounds, that is your choice. We will not be providing gloves or masks (PPE) for anyone other than our judges, volunteers, and management staff.
- Exhibitors must properly dispose of all PPE by taking it home or depositing it in one of the trashcans on site.
- Exhibitors who have qualified, will be called back into the ring for the awards presentation. Qualifiers should wear their mask if not vaccinated and/or, if possible, stand six feet apart during the awards presentation.
- If you have been vaccinated you do not need to wear a mask.
- Remember to social distance while at the “white” boards.
